Our new provider (ABM) will be responsible for the menus and preparation of all school meals. We are sure that children will be very positive about the changes which they will see in the coming months.

For families, the change of provider will mean a slightly different way of ordering and paying for meals. We will be sending home more information about this (as well as menus) in the next week. We may also need to send some updates over the summer holidays so please look out for these. We also plan to put all this information on our website to support the transition process.

As with any new system, there may be a few 'teething issues' – if, in September, you are having any difficulties, let us know and we will be happy to help.

Please Collect all Medicines

If your child has any medication in school (inhalers etc.) then we need you to collect these next Friday. We can't send medicines home with your child so we do need them to be collected by an adult (from the class teacher).

We ask that you check the expiry date and the supply levels of all medicines over the summer holiday. Please return all medicines (clearly labelled with your child's name) ready for Tuesday 2nd September.

If your child requires medicine for the first time, please speak to the office – we need you to complete permission forms before we can accept any new medication.
