Happy's Circus - Sunday 6th September

We are pleased to announce that the Circus is coming to school!

This is a new event for us and something we have been trying to organise for the past few years and finally, we have been lucky to secure a date.

So, on Sunday 6th September, the Big Top will be put up on the school playing field and Happy's Circus will perform their show - no animals are involved. There may be water though! The show will start at 2.00pm and will be finished by approximately 4.00pm, including an interval. It should be a great afternoon of entertainment. We will be selling refreshments (burgers, hot dogs etc) from 12 noon until 2pm and drinks/tuck items will be available during the interval.

The Big Top can hold a maximum of 600 people and everyone will need a ticket including pre-schoolers. Tickets will be on sale during w/c 1st June on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and w/c 8th June on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. They cost £8.00 each or £30.00 for a family of 4. We need to sell tickets prior to the event and before school finishes on Friday 17th July. You can also buy tickets for friends and family.

If you are unable to get into school to purchase your tickets you can send the money in an envelop marked 'Circus' together with a ticket request form that will be available from the school office or the website from Monday $1^{\rm st}$ June.
