As you may have heard, Wheatfield Plus have been re-inventing their activity programme ... here's an update on some of the fun they're having ...



Future Home Learning Arrangements

All schools have been asked to put together a plan for how they will handle any future home learning whether that be for the closure of a single bubble or in the event of another full lockdown.

I wanted to assure families that we have a full, robust plan to cover each eventuality. This builds on our previous home learning with:

- ✓ A weekly overview of curriculum activities that will be uploaded to our website.
- ✓ Daily English and maths tasks that will be uploaded the day before they are taught.
- ✓ Daily English and maths videos that will be uploaded to the year team's YouTube channel.
- ✓ Two weekly videos to support work across the wider curriculum.
- ✓ Teachers will also signpost families to additional video content from other providers e.g. BBC clips, Oak National Academy.

In addition to the above, teachers will be available by email to support families and children and there will be additional 'check ins' in the event of an extended lockdown.
