### This Week at Wheatfield and at Home

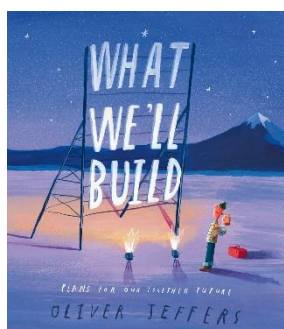

This time around we do need to secure an order of at least 100 T-shirts (and currently have around 20 orders placed) so please support us if you can.

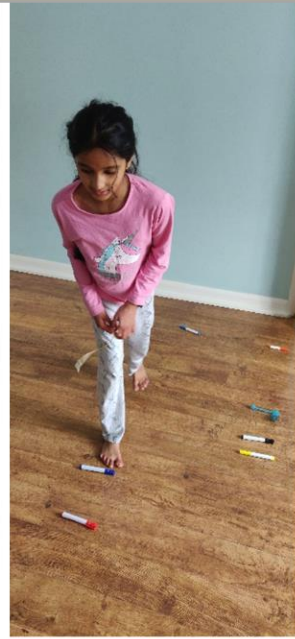

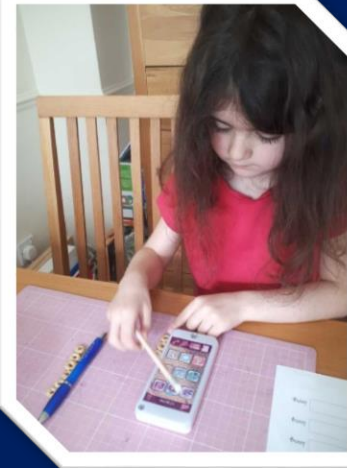
