Science Week

This week we have celebrated British Science Week. We have completed a range of activities across different areas of science. We have been going on bug hunts, searching for Scientist and inventors and inventing our own Robo Bugs in line with this year's theme, 'Innovating for the Future'.

Our main event took off with a bang. Children were designing and making their own space shuttles. We tested the shuttles and measured the distance they travelled. We discussed what we can do to improve our space craft and to make it fly even further. The children considered wingspan, the shape of the nose cone and air resistance.
