Children in Years 4, 5 & 6 will take part in South Gloucestershire's online pupil survey this term. This is an anonymous survey to help schools and the Local Authority establish the views and opinions of pupils. All LA schools are taking part. The main points of the survey are:

- It enables the voice of South Gloucestershire children and young people to be heard
- It takes place every 2 years
- Pupils are non-identifiable and the survey is secure and confidential
- The results help schools plan better PSHE education and support for children
- It helps schools monitor the impact of their work
- It helps South Gloucestershire Council, public health and other organisations provide the local services that children and young people need
