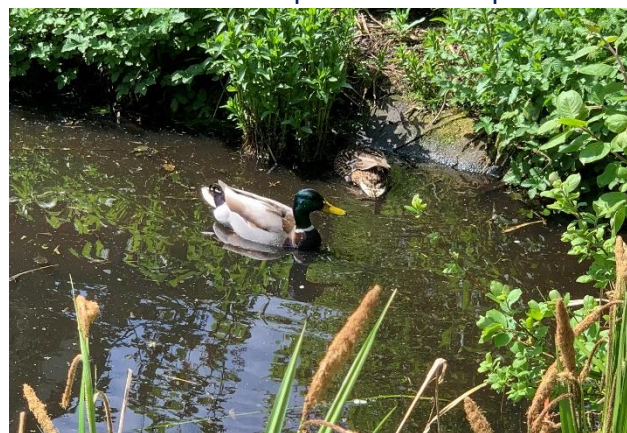
County Athletics Finals

Uniform Reminder

A quick reminder about school uniform.

- ✓ School shoes should be black and plain. Trainers can only be worn on PE days.
- ✓ Sandals may be worn in the summer term but these need to provide adequate support / protection to the foot (no flip-flops).
- ✓ Grey shorts or blue / white gingham check dresses may be worn in the summer term.
- ✓ PE days: shorts, hoodies or leggings should be plain navy (a PE uniform) and a T-shirt in your child's house colour.
- ✓ Jewellery should not be worn to school (the only exception being a plain stud earring).
