Parents' Evening

We are looking forward to welcoming you all for parents' evening next week. Just a reminder that we are asking you, wherever possible, to arrange child care for your child during this event. We will be running a crèche but would prefer it if you only use this facility if you have no alternative. This will help to keep the numbers manageable.

Some reminders about attendance

Being late for school: Being late regularly can have a negative impact on your child's achievement. Learning starts as soon as our doors open. Please be on-site by 8.45am every day to get your child off to the best start.

Register procedures: The school is open from 8.45am each morning. Registers are taken at 8.55am and registration closes at 9.00am. Children arriving after 9.00am must enter the school through the main doors and sign in at the school office. Children arriving after 9.00am (but before 9.15am) will be marked as late (an L code on the register). Children arriving after 9.15am will receive an unauthorised absence code.

Leave of Absence Requests: All requests for leave of absence during term time must be made on the 'Application for Leave of Absence' form available on the school website or from the school office not less than one week before the date for which leave of absence is requested. The school will decide whether each request will be authorised or unauthorised in line with this policy. The school strongly discourages families from taking children out of school during term time (even if it is not for a holiday)
