School communication reminder

Please can I remind parents that email correspondence or messages for staff should come through school comms/school email rather than directly to staff emails. This ensures that staff receive emails within school hours and not at evening and weekends. This is in place to support the wellbeing of staff at school.

Sometimes, it may be that you need to pass on a message to the teacher which can be given verbally to a member of staff on the door in the morning. Alternatively, please message the school office via school comms as this is monitored frequently during the school day and is a more efficient way for you to get a message to school. Please note that the office is open between the hours of 8am – 4pm from Monday to Friday in term time.

We know that some parents do not work school hours and may not be able to talk to a member of staff in the morning or at collection at the end of the day. In this case, we would ask that you contact school via **school comms** or email the **school office** office@wheatfieldprimary.com who can forward on the message to the class teacher or other relevant adult in school. Please note that this email address is monitored less frequently during the day and should not be used for urgent messages.

We ask that parents do not enter school through the playground doors and go up to classrooms at the beginning or end of the day as this is the time that teachers and teaching assistants are preparing for the day ahead or the following day.

Science Week - We celebrated British Science Week from the 11th - 15th March alongside schools across the nation. This year the theme was 'time'. Every year group carried out a range of scientific investigations. Year 3 thought about how time relates to science and represented life cycles in different ways. They also created balloon rockets to investigate friction and resistance. Year 5 created pendulum timers and did a human growth survey to see how our bodies grow as we get older.

We were also lucky enough to have some parent volunteers come in to speak to KS2 children about their STEM careers. The children thoroughly enjoyed this and had lots of interesting questions. It was lovely to talk to the children about how inspired many of them were to pursue a career involving science, technology, engineering and maths.
